Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate and graduate trumpet students and advising undergraduate and graduate students. Serve as administrative coordinator of wind performance area. Be involved in recruitment and participate in workshops, off-campus visitations, and performances at local, state, national and international levels. Additional responsibilities may include teaching brass related classes, coaching small ensembles and teaching jazz improvisation and serving on department, school and university committees, as assigned by the Department Head.

Qualifications include active performer with successful college-level or equivalent professional teaching experience. Record of professional achievement and scholarly / creative activity and promise for continued success in teaching and performance. Earned Doctoral degree in music, or the equivalent in professional experience.

Salary to be determined based on qualifications.

Applications should include 1) a letter of application, 2) a complete vita and repertoire list, 3) a recent CD (varied repertory recommended), 4) the names, addresses, telephone numbers, and email addresses of 3-5 references.
